The year 2006 marked 25 years of HIV/AIDS. In June 1981, scientists in the United States reported the first clinical evidence of a disease that would become known as Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome, or AIDS. Twenty-five years later, the AIDS epidemic has spread to every corner of the world. Over 22 million people have lost their lives to the disease. Over 39 million people are living with HIV today, the highest number since the beginning of the epidemic. ►

- A total of \$448,500 was raised for calendar year 2006 grantmaking.

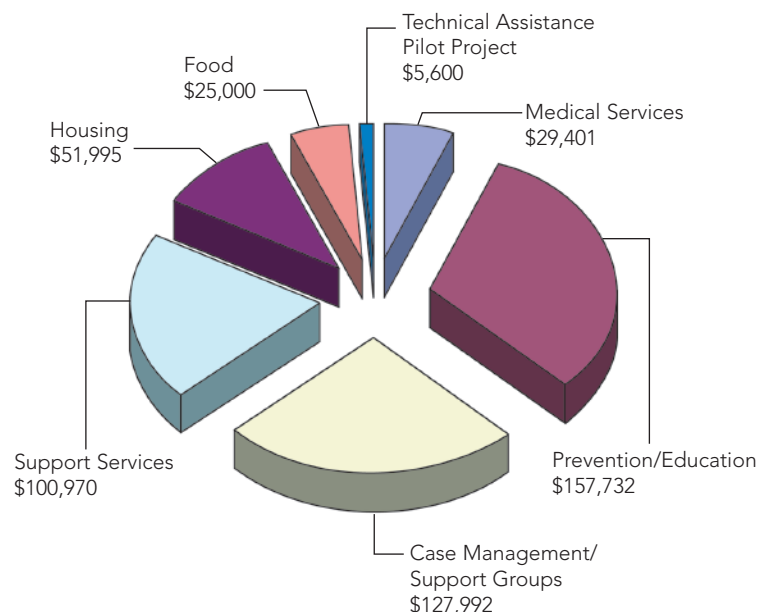
### Grant Allocations

### Technical Assistance Pilot Project

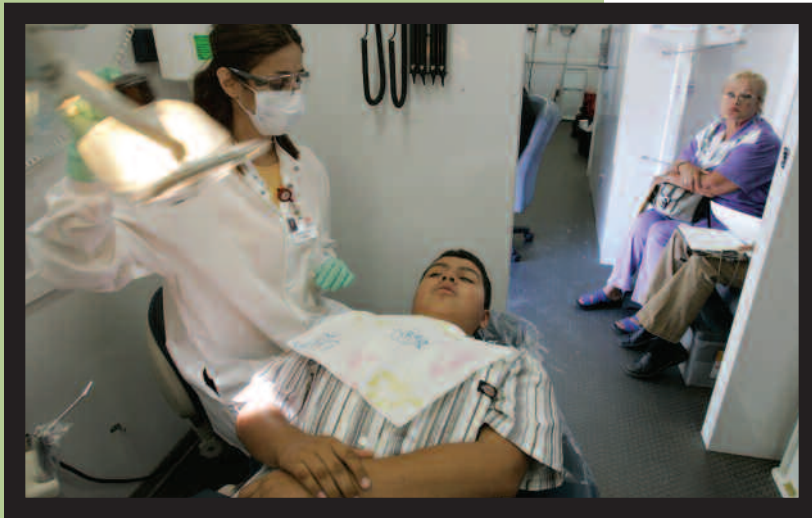
- Nine workshops were held over eight months. Fifteen grantees attended the series.
